**of test of ability to study urban planning for the 2020/2021 academic year**  
**(First application deadline)**

The ability test to study urban planning, which may be taken only once in the academic year, will be held in the premises of the Faculty of Architecture of the University of Ljubljana, Zoisova 12, 1000 Ljubljana, according to the following schedule:

Before the test, you must settle the amount of **EUR 62.50**, to cover the costs of preparation and implementation of the test, **as per the attached invoice**.

**YOU MUST BRING TO THE TEST:**

- **drawing tools, or necessary instruments: writing implements** (*ink pen, ball-point pen*), **pencil, soft eraser, triangle;**
- **personal identification document** (*identity card, passport, driving licence also acceptable*);
- **photocopy of certificate of payment, showing surname and name of candidate.**

The test of ability to study urban planning assesses the following fundamental skills, talents and knowledge of candidates: aptitude for understanding and expressing spatial conceptualisation, aptitude for the subject of arranging and developing the physical space, aptitude for analytical thought, cooperation in a group, leadership and communication.

In an interview with the candidate before a three-member committee, we seek to reveal:

The motivational and emotional capacity and the ability to communicate:

- the motives and emotional affinity with towns and urban planning;
- their mental ease in conversation;
- sensitivity to the environment (*culture, general events, location, form, etc.*);
- imagination or wealth of ideas (*in proposed works or changes*);
- originality.

General intellectual and analytical ability and the capacity to lead:

- ability to read a space (*evaluation of the space, relationships, circumstances, etc.*);
- recognising possible change or innovation (*correction of circumstances or relationships*);
- ability to seek new paths (*or approaches*) and a sense of what is essential;
- organisational skills (*in a narrative or drawn presentation*) and speaking with authority;
- critical thinking with regard to forms, development programmes, processes in modern society and so forth.



Candidates from abroad, who due to the epidemiological situation in their countries cannot for practical reasons attend the ability test in the July session, will be allowed to take the test in the autumn session. These candidates must notify their non-attendance to the head of the Student Affairs office by e-mail at: [mojca.rozman@fa.uni-lj.si](mailto:mojca.rozman@fa.uni-lj.si) no later than by 7 July 2020.

The ability test will be conducted in person and candidates will be required to abide consistently by the measures and recommendations of the National Institute of Public Health (NIJZ) regarding containment of the spread of COVID-19 infection.
